## A letter from Sír Julius Benedict to <u>Sír Peter Henry</u> Edlin.

Julius Benedict, 1804-1885 was a German born composer and conductor who spent most of his life living and working in London. He was knighted in 1871. He wrote "The Lily of Killarney". There is a blue plaque on his house in Manchester Square, London.
